



Reach Out of Montgomery County is a 501(c)(3) volunteer healthcare provider, founded in 1994 by Wright State University Boonshoft School of Medicine, Public Health Dayton and Montgomery County, and the Montgomery County Medical Society. Reach Out is supported by local foundations, grants, corporate and individual giving. A grant from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation in 1994 initiated the Reach Out Program.

Mission: Reach Out's mission is to provide access to health care services for the underserved/ uninsured population in Montgomery County, without restraints, utilizing the professional skills of volunteer physicians, nurses, pharmacists, translators and other health care professionals.

Eligibility: All age groups, uninsured/underinsured, with income at or below 200% of the FPL. Identification is required at clinic registration; photo ID preferred, driver's license, state ID. Patients living outside of Montgomery County will be eligible on a case by case basis.

Pharmacy: Charitable pharmacy fills/refills medication(s) at no cost according to patient eligibility and grant fund availability. Formulary available on website. Prescriptions are filled for Reach Out clinic patients as well as those meeting eligibility from area hospitals/specialty clinics.

Pharmacy Hours: Monday-Friday 12:00 pm – 5:00 pm

Medical Clinics: The clinics offer an alternative to emergency room visits for minor illnesses and chronic conditions that need immediate attention. Clinic visits are at no cost to the patient.

Laboratory Testing: are at no cost for the eligible patient at Reach Out clinics.

Monday Pediatric Clinic, beginning at 5:00 pm

Wednesday/Thursday Walk-in Clinics, beginning at 5:00 pm

Friday Clinics by appointment, beginning at 12:00 pm

Behavioral Health: Behavioral Health services are available during Thursday evening clinics.

Physical Therapy: Physical Therapists are available by appointments on Tuesdays and Fridays.

Specialist/Diagnostic Referrals: Reach Out clinic physicians may refer clinic patients to local specialists. Cost is dependent on that specialist's office guidelines. In some cases the physicians' professional fees are waived; however, patients may incur costs for tests or procedures performed.

Case Management: RN case managers to facilitate navigation of medical needs throughout the community. Call Nurseline for assistance 937-258-2000 ext 111.

Volunteer/Service Learning/Student Clinical Rotations: Reach Out provides collaboration among area universities for medical education and training.
